### **Revised Recommendation**

- 2.1 The Council recommend to the Executive Member for Planning and Transport that, subject to the occurrence of each of the following prior to the completion of a Deed of Release of the section 52 agreement, namely:-
  - (a) the Planning Committee having authorised the grant of one or more planning permissions which the Committee has confirmed provide for the development of Blue Mountain Golf Course, including the provision of public open space, substantially in accordance with Policy SA 7 of the Site Allocations Local Plan (adopted July 2013),
