 - review of local arrangements
 - everyone's responsibility
- School exam results

Leisure

Coral Reef Enhancement Programme

- Iconic leisure feature of regional significance
- Roof nearing end of design life
- £11M refurbishment AND upgrade planned
 - new roof on pool hall
 - two new flumes
 - new flume tower
 - refurbishment of changing and ancillary facilities
 - upgrade sauna world

Bracknell Town Centre

- Major investor review 2013/14
- Bracknell Forest Council role pivotal in maintaining focus and viability
- Development Agreement unconditionality imminent
- Resources now needed for Council's own planned infrastructure investment
- Capital Programme report and separate confidential report outline details
 - replacement park
 - highways improvements
 - automated traffic and car park information systems
 - public open space improvements
 - bus station purchase
 - car park lease
- **Capital spend recommended to Council**



Environment: Waste Disposal

- Waste Regulations (2011) review
 - separation and recycling requirements likely to be met
- Joint Waste Disposal Contract
 - ground breaking PFI
 - on-going dispute about additional recycle income
 - case strong but need to be ready to defend
 - still looking for settlement

- clean bill of health

Budget 2015/16

- revenue and capital plans agreed for consultation
- full debate at next Council
