9. Question Submitted Under Council Procedure Rule 10

By Councillor Mrs Temperton to Councillor Dr Barnard, Executive Member for Children, Young People and Learning:

There are now 12 schools in Bracknell Forest (almost 1/3) which have been judged by Ofsted to be Requiring Improvement, despite all the hard work going on to 'close the gap' and raise achievement. The Council offers a pre- Ofsted check which is taken up by some schools. These monitoring sessions are invaluable, giving the Head, Staff and Governors direction, focus and support to meet the challenges.

We believe that all Bracknell Forest schools should be given this review annually to ensure that the changing bench marks are being met and that best practice is shared.

With the recruitment and appointment to 7 vacant headships in Bracknell Forest this year, we would suggest that such support is very necessary.

Will the Council implement this annual support to all schools?
