- (6) Information which reveals that the authority proposes to give under any enactment a notice under or by virtue of which requirements are imposed on a person.

- (6) Information which reveals that the authority proposes to make an order or direction under any enactment.
- (7) Information relating to any action taken or to be taken in connection with the prevention, investigation or prosecution of crime.
