Term Dates 2018/19 response analysis

Headteachers, Chairs of Governors and Union representatives were consulted on a suggested option.

10 Headteachers and 5 Chairs of Governors responded to the consultation.

Comments

9 comments were received; all from Headteachers.

Of these:

Secondary Headteachers discussed the option of moving the May half term to the first week in June to even out the length of the terms however this was not possible due to exam scheduling.

8 asked that the Christmas break be changed to break up on Friday 21 December 2018 and return to school on 7 January 2019. This change is reflected in the proposed term dates.

The other comment asked for an additional holiday after Easter Monday. However this would make the summer term even shorter and was not acceptable.

The recommended option is the option attached.
