Re Planning Application for a premises licence by the Co-op on Sparrowhawk Way, Jennett's Park

I have a vested interest in this application that is more than the general public, because I live opposite the proposed shop.

The basis for my objection is that granting a licence for excessive opening hours will not promote the licensing objectives, particularly the prevention of crime, disorder and anti social behaviour. Enabling the Co- op to sell alcohol so early and late in the day would be detrimental to Bracknell Forest council aims and objectives - for example this does not promote "well-being and a healthy lifestyle", as quoted on your Homestart program. I would also like to point out that it is directly opposite a school and community centre, which also does not set a good example to the many young children passing the premises each day.

I am a resident who enjoys the benefits of living on a quiet estate and look forward to having access to a local shop, but am concerned that the long opening hours will result in more noise for us locals and affect the public safety. I fail to see the need to close so late, as there will be no passing trade as it seems likely that it will be a service for the locals.

I would urge the committee/panel to consider the findings of the Health Impact Assessment, referred to by residents in many towns in the UK, which gives evidence of the negative effects of the flexible licensing hours.

I would therefore like to recommend that the hours are reduced to a more reasonable opening time of 7.00-22.00 hrs
