GCSE full course

The GCSE full course was available in 4 schools, although 1 student in a 5th school also took the examination. 284 students took the examination (254 in 2009). 63% of entries were girls, 37% were boys

75.4% of entries were graded A* - C (72% in 2009)

100% of entries were graded A* - G (98.4% in 2009)

All 50 students in one school achieved grade C or above.

77% of girls achieved A* - C (80% in 2009)

71% of boys achieved A* - C (68.7% in 2009)

GCSE short course

The GCSE full course was available in 3 schools, although 1 student in a 4th school also took the examination. 246 students took the examination (418 in 2009). 45% of entries were girls, 55% were boys

A Level

31 students from 4 schools took the A level examination in 2010 (23 in 2009), of whom 24 were girls and 7 were boys.
