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The £60,980 allocated to schools below MFG in 2012-2013 has yet to be re-allocated in the revised formula allocation.

There is no reference to Appendix B Early Years Single Funding Formula or C rates, as there is no funding implication arising from these factors.

The difference of £111,392 in column **M** is the deduction in budget that is proposed to create a Contingency fund to assist schools where necessary to meet the KS 1 class size requirement of classes up to 30 pupils. Paragraphs 72-75 of the consultation document sets out this proposal.
