Community Infrastructure Levy - Regulation 123 list

Regulation 123 of the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Regulations 2010 requires the charging authority to publish a list of infrastructure projects or types of infrastructure that it intends to fund wholly or partly through CIL revenue.

Infrastructure in the list below will no longer be secured through s106 planning obligations. The intention is to ensure that there is no duplication in the use of both CIL and s106 for the same project.

The list does not signify a commitment by the Council to deliver the project, nor does it indicate any priority. The list will be subject to regular review.
