# A fantastic opportunity

We are delivering a new state-of-the-art replacement for Frimley Park Hospital

Building a hospital on the current site is not a viable option:

- it would cause significant disruption to our patients, staff, and hospital services

- it would be more expensive

- it would be impossible to complete a phased build by our deadline of 2030

As a result, we are now actively looking at alternative locations for a replacement Frimley Park Hospital.

## Planning and restrictions criteria

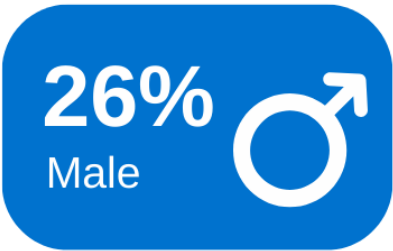
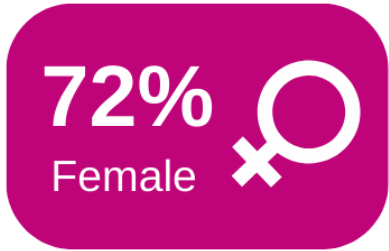
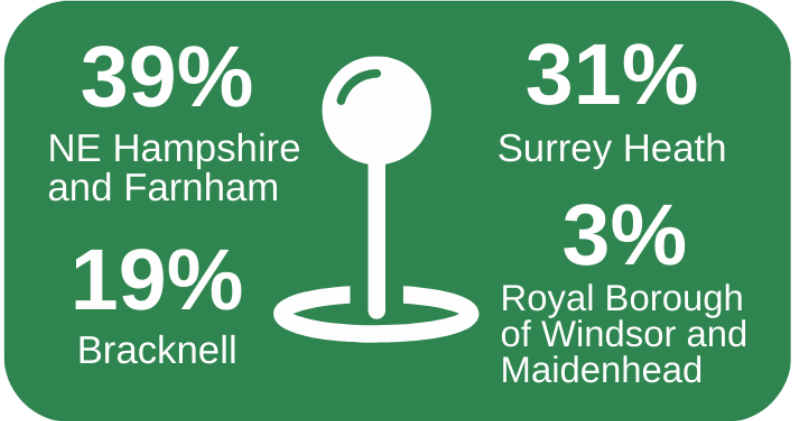
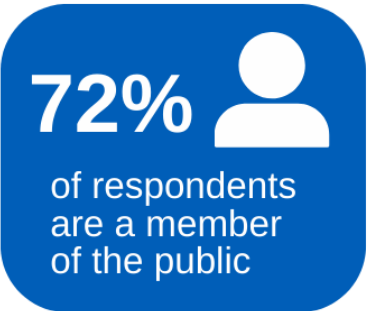
