NOTICE OF KEY DECISION

Notice is hereby given that the Executive Member for Council Strategy and Community Cohesion is to be asked to make a key decision on 31 Aug 2022 in respect of the following:

TITLE: Bracknell Town Centre Development Agreement, 8th Variation

SERVICE AREA: Place, Planning & Regeneration

PURPOSE OF DECISION:

The Development Agreement contains a Relevant Date by which the Developer will discharge key conditions. One of those conditions has not yet been discharged but is in progress. To enable the matter to be concluded a further extension for the Relevant Date has been requested. The new date is the 6th October 2022.

ISSUE REFERENCE: I109149

This notice is being given in accordance with regulation 11 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 in that the decision is urgent and it is not possible to give 28 or 5 days' notice as normally required by regulations 9 and 10 of the decision, due to late notification that the condition had not been discharged, thereby necessitating an extension to the agreement.
