#### 10. Appointment of Executive Support Members

To consider the following Motion by Councillor Bettison

(a) That the following Members be appointed to the named portfolio area as Executive Support Members

(nominations to follow)

- (b) That Executive Support Members shall have the following duties:
  - (i) to assist, support and advise the relevant Executive Member in the exercise of his or her responsibilities,
  - (ii) to carry out particular tasks and projects as agreed with the Executive Member from time to time;
  - to attend public and private meetings of the Executive as an observer and in the absence of the Executive Member to propose motions and speak (but not to vote);
  - (iv) in the absence of the executive member to speak at meetings of the Council on matters relating to the allocated portfolio area.
- (c) That Executive Support Members may serve on Scrutiny Panels and working groups provided that they must withdraw from any discussion of matters within the portfolio area in which they act as Executive Support Member. It would therefore be inappropriate for Executive Support Members to act as chairman or vice chairman of a scrutiny panel.
- (d) that Executive Support Members shall not be appointed to the role of chairman or vice chairman of the Licensing & Safety Committee or the Planning & Highways Committee
- (e) That the Constitution Review Group be asked to consider any consequential adjustments to the Constitution to reflect the creation of these posts and to bring forward recommendations to the next ordinary meeting of the Council.
