Dear Sir/Madam,

1. I under signed Taj Miah owner of the premises (name mentioned above) where I am running a restaurant business since January 2018. Recently, I came to know that your office has taken initiatives to review of my premises licence as you have grounds to believe that I failed to meet the licensing objectives of prevention of crime and disorder, as illegal working has been identified at this premises.

2. Also I came to know from your referral letter that an enforcement visit was conducted on the date of 11 November 2013, 06 September 2017 and 18 November 2017 and identified several male illegal workers at this premises, due to this a total of £45,000.00 civil penalty was issued which has remained unpaid.

3. For your information and kind consideration I like to mention that I have been doing business at this premise since January 2018. I am completely unaware about the incidence, deploying illegal workers and the dues of civil penalties.

4. Already I invested all my savings, efforts and capabilities to make the business successful. During my period I never sold any Alcohol to the under aged person or committed any illegal activities or abet or allow or encourage anyone to do any illegal activities at my business premises or anywhere. I am law abiding ad regularly paying taxes.

5. If the authority makes a decision to revoke the premises licence I will be in a great trouble and will become a fully frustrated person. No hope and inspiration will remain for me to survive in this world.

6. I am giving assurance for your satisfaction that any sorts of illegal activities will not be taking place during my time and I will be taking following actions plan to meet the licensing objectives of prevention of crime and disorder. I believe these prongs should lead to a more positive working relationship with the police and enforcement agencies who may or may not be prepared to engage during my occupancy.

7. Considering the above circumstances I would like to submit to the authority that the revoking of the above mentioned premises licence would be prejudicial to me. Thus authority will allow me to continue my business at this premise.
