Good afternoon

I would like to object to the new premises alcohol license reference LI/18/00269/LAPRE1 for The Royal Foresters pub in Ascot, made by Oakman Inns and Restaurants.

I am a resident on Priory Road, living in close proximity to the pub, and whilst I welcome the regeneration of the long-abandoned site I don't think that their proposed closing times are appropriate having residents so close by and two schools either side.

We live in a residential area which is becoming more residential by the month with new premises being built in close proximity to The Foresters. Having patrons leaving this establishment at 01:30 am on Friday and Saturday (Sunday mornings!) will obviously create noise disturbance and greater potential for anti-social behaviour to us on Priory Road. It was bad enough when the old Beefeater used to close up at 00:30 so this additional hour will make a large difference to our quality of life.

The local residents here are generally families with young children or pensioners in retirement and the extended licensing request isn't appropriate in my opinion.

I hope that you will take my objection into account when evaluating this application.
