Subject: Objection to Royal Foresters Licensing Application

Dear Sir,

I wish to object to the recent licensing application made by the Royal Foresters.

I understand that they wish to serve alcohol until midnight Monday thru Friday and on Saturdays until 0100.

I wish to object on two grounds -

1) the prevention of public nuisance. The Royal Foresters is not situated in a town centre or an environment that is appropriate for a late night license. It is situated on the edge of a residential area (Priory Road) which is lined with private houses. The area is typically quiet meaning that noise travels at night - the noise of cars leaving or people walking from the pub late in the evening will be significant for those of us living in the vicinity,

2) the prevention of crime and disorder. The houses on Priory Road were built at the turn of the last century and therefore there are no garages, everyone has to park their car outside the front of their house. There is no barrier of any significance between these cars and the pavement. Having people leaving the pub late at night and then walking along the cars is conducive to opportunistic vandalism and theft.
