**Mr Zafer Koc (Trading as King's Kebabs) – Bagshot Road**

The site is located in the lay-by along Bagshot Road outside Kwikfit Tyre and Exhaust. This trader sells kebabs, burgers and hotdogs.

Mr Koc has held a street trading consent for this site since May 1996, this is the earliest record on file, however a previous consent may have been held but there are no records for this.

There was some previous history of complaints regarding this trader, regarding trading hours, traffic congestion, contaminated water on the highway and parking the vehicle in a private residential road. Notes from on the file from previous officers advise that these issues were addressed and resolved.

Below is a table of complaints and issues since 11 February 2010

11/02/2010	Complaint from Bracknell Leisure Centre regarding van being stored there after service and littering the grounds with waste food.	Officers attended site, observed waste food and containers and requested van be moved and stored in suitable area.
22/03/2010	Complaint that King's Kebabs were not removing van after service but leaving it at pitch. Officers observed van parked up at pitch on 2 consecutive days.	Officers monitored and requested van moved.
16/04/2010	Defective tail light and damaged roof sign.	Officers visited. Mr Koc had to be advised numerous times before eventually repairing both.
15/11/2010	VOSA prohibited vehicle for numerous defects during Street Trader check with Licensing, TVP, VOSA, EH & TS.	New MOT issued by VOSA garage.
25/08/2011	Fixed Penalty Notice issued to Mr Zafer Koc for failure to Produce Waste Transfer Notes. Fine (£300) was not paid within the specified time period, however it was paid approximately one month later than required. Both Mr Zafer Koc and Mr Sinan Koc were invited to attend a PACE Interview to answer questions with regards to waste disposal arrangements for the business. Neither individuals attended the appointments for the interviews.	Fixed Penalty Notice issued
16/09/2011	Complaints from John Mortimer's that King's Kebabs turning up early (approx 16.50) and asking customers visiting premises to move their vehicles in order for King's to access the pitch.	Officers monitored and witnessed early arrival change. Advised arrival could only be 15 minutes prior to service.

11/11/2011	More complaints from businesses in Humphries Yard to advise yet again turning up at 17.00 hours.	Diary sheets sent.
16/12/2011	<p>Vehicle stopped during a vehicle check on the Bagshot Road by TVP and VOSA. Vehicle prohibited by VOSA for defective front tyre, defective headlight and brake light. Stopped by TVP and charged with breaching VOSA prohibition and charged with dangerous driving. Vehicle impounded.
24/12/2011	Advised by VOSA that vehicle failed MOT.	Variation for new vehicle submitted.
29/12/2011	Further complaints that vehicle was trading before permitted hours.	Officers monitored and advised complainants to continue to keep diary sheets.
30/12/2011	Officers went to visit the site to monitor arrival observed arriving at pitch at 17.00 hours	
31/12/2011	Observed by Steve Loudoun on Bagshot Road at 02.45 on New Year's morning and trading.	
11/01/2012	Observed by Charlotte Scott and Gareth Morris arriving at pitch at 17.10 hours. The operatives that were on the vehicle at the time of the visit were Mehmet Yakar and Sunev Korkman, neither could find nor were wearing street trading assistant badges.	Written informal warning and formal food hygiene improvement notice issued.
18/9/2015	Complaint received regarding trading before permitted trading hours. Officers visited the site on 18 September 2015 and trading vehicle was observed arriving at the Shell Petrol Station at 17:25,	Warning letter and invitation to attend office to discuss sent on 22 <sup>nd</sup> September 2015

03/08/2016	and then moving onto the pitch at 17:30. Complaint - The kebab van has started to turn up before 5.45pm again at the above location.	Operator Contacted and spoken to by Officer – Officer now left the authority
10/1/2018	Complaint –The kebab van that normally parks in the layby on the Bagshot Road outside Kwik Fit has been parking in the Car Park in front of JM Property Fire Exit Doors. It has come to their attention this morning as there is lots of oil on the floor and an employee almost slipped on the oil.	Operator contacted and complaint discussed – No further action taken
15/3/2018	Complaint – vehicle arrived early to pitch on 15 <sup>th</sup> March 2018	Warning email sent advising any further breaches would result in a referral to Licensing Panel.
