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## **INDEPENDENT REVIEWING OFFICER ANNUAL REPORT 2019/2020**

### **1 PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to present the Independent Reviewing Officer (IRO) annual report of the Conference and Reviewing Service to the Executive Member of Children and Young People and Bracknell Forest Safeguarding Board in line with statutory expectations and good practice.

### **2 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

- 2.1 At the end of 2019/20 reporting year there were 142 Children Looked After by Bracknell-Forest. The annual report provides quantitative and qualitative data analysis on the work undertaken by the Independent Reviewing Service with these children and young people during the reporting period.
