The first will be calculated in the winter of 2011-12 using the finalised data then available. This will be payable early in 2012 as a first instalment with a 28% capital element. The maximum payable at this time will be half the total reward. The second instalment will be calculated in the winter of 2012/13, again using the finalised data for the indicators available at this point. The first instalment will be subtracted and the remaining amount paid as the second instalment, with a 28% element before the end of the 2012-13 financial year.
