X X XXXXXXXX XXXXXXXXXX XXXXXXXXXX London Road	<p>X XXXXXXXX explains X has been directly affected by parking on the verges of London Road causing visibility issues when exiting X property. X is therefore pleased by the proposal to install wooden posts on the verges adjacent to X property.</p> <p>X asks if the wooden posts will be sufficiently robust to withstand attempts to park on the verge? X notes that in other areas of the borough that flower planters and concrete bollards have been used to prevent parking.</p> <p>X notes that it is intended to install 'No waiting at any time' restrictions on both sides of the road. X hopes that this will stop the lorries from waiting to enter the timber merchants.</p> <p>X XXXXXXXX asks that if once the wooden posts are installed will these not be sufficient to stop parking on the northern side of the road? X adds as a resident X would prefer not to have waiting restrictions as these would appear to be unduly restrictive when the posts will be stopping parking on the verge. X objects to the installation of 'No waiting at any time' restrictions on the northern side of the road.</p>	<p>Wooden posts have been used successfully across the borough as a low cost parking deterrent. We have no reason to believe that they will not be as equally efficient in this location.</p> <p>The Council consider that both the verge protection and parking restrictions are necessary. Installing only the verge protection measures may lead to the cars being displaced from the verge onto the carriageway. Given the status of the road and the volume of traffic that uses it we do not consider it to be safe for the vehicles to park on the road. Additionally, should vehicles park on the carriageway the visibility issues for X XXXXXXXX will remain.</p>	Proceed as advertised.
