X X XXXXXX  XX Wagbullock Rise	<p>X XXXXXX raises a number of issues regarding the public consultation process on the proposed disabled parking bay.</p> <p>X XXXXXX raises the possibility that residents may wish to install EV chargers on their property but will be unable to do so as a disabled parking space is now on the road and parking in front of their property will now be illegal. X asks if anything will be done to appease these residents?</p> <p>X XXXXXX suggests that the disabled parking bay is likely to be further from the resident's property than where they park at present.</p> <p>X XXXXXX states that parking is already a problem in Wagbullock Rise. X states that the installation of the disabled bay will simply exacerbate this problem and cause further problems. X asks how the Council intends to address this?</p>	<p>X XXXXXX has been contacted by Officers regarding the issues X raised concerning the consultation process.</p> <p>The installation of the disabled parking bay is unlikely to affect the ability of any resident to place an EV charger on their own private property. Parking on street in most roads is on a first come first served basis and it's not possible to reserve a specific on street space for a single property, so regardless of the presence of the disabled parking bay there is no guarantee that the same parking space will always be available for a specific resident if they did have an EV charging point on their property.</p> <p>The disabled parking bay has been placed as close to the applicant's house as possible and its position has been agreed with them.</p> <p>Whilst the Council appreciates the parking issues in Wagbullock Rise, the reality is that the applicant already parks their vehicle in the road so there will be no net loss of parking due to this proposal. 8 additional parking spaces were constructed in Wagbullock Rise approximately 7 years ago. Given the lack of suitable space there are no plans for additional parking spaces to be built at present.</p>	<b>Proceed as advertised</b>
