1 Purpose of report

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to seek agreement from the Executive Member to set the 2023-24 Early Years and High Needs Block elements of the Schools Budget on the basis of recommendations made by the Schools Forum.
- 1.2 The Executive Member has observer status on the Schools Forum, receiving all reports and entitled to attend meetings, and is therefore actively involved in the operation and deliberations of the Schools Forum.

2 Recommendation

2.1 That the Executive Member AGREES the budget proposals approved by the Schools Forum at its meetings on 12 January and 9 March 2023, as set out in paragraph 3.1 of Appendix A and paragraph 3.1 of Appendix B.

3 Reasons for Recommendation

3.1 To ensure that the 2023-24 Schools Budget is set in accordance with the views of the Executive, schools, the Schools Forum and the statutory funding framework.

4 Alternative options considered

4.1 These have been considered during the budget consultation stage and previous reports to the Schools Forum.

5 Supporting information

- 5.1 Whilst spending on the Schools Budget is funded by the ring fenced Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG), and therefore outside of the Council's funding responsibilities, Local Authorities (LA) retain a statutory duty to set the overall level of the Schools Budget before the start of each financial year. In deciding the relevant amount, LAs must plan to spend at least to the level of estimated DSG and can also take account of any accumulated under or overspending on the Schools Budget from previous years.
- 5.2 At its meeting of 7 February 2023, the Executive agreed that the Executive Member for Children, Young People and Learning approves the detailed 2023-24 budget allocations for High Needs pupils and Early Years provisions, up to the estimated level of available resources.

- 5.3 Appendix A presents the recommendations approved by the Schools Forum at its meeting of 12 January in respect of the Early Years elements of the DSG and Appendix B setting out the recommendations approved by the Schools Forum at its meeting of 9 March for the High Needs Block element of the DSG. These Appendices also contain links to the council's website where the full reports can be viewed which the Executive Member is now recommended to endorse.
- 5.4 Budget decisions taken by the Executive Member have always been in accordance with the wishes of the Schools Forum, and the recommendations on this paper maintain that position. Executive Member decisions around the Schools Block element of the Schools Budget were taken on 17 January.
