

## Public consultation responses to Caring for Our Carers – the next five years, All Age Integrated Carers Strategy 2024-2029 survey.

The strategy was out for public consultation for 12 weeks.

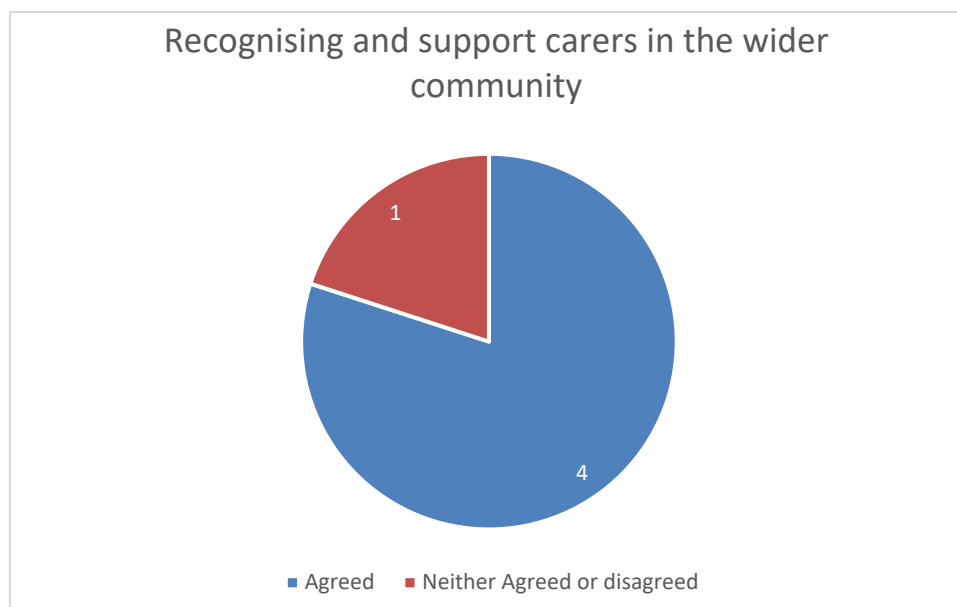
Despite our efforts to promote this widely there were only 5 responses. All 5 completely agreed with the Vision. 4 completely agreed with the priorities. 1 neither agreed or disagreed with the priorities but noted they had only read the one-page infographic and not the whole document. 1 person noted that support with financial matters would be useful, this was an area already been identified in the strategy under priority 3.

A period of significant targeted consultation had taken place previously with over a thousand carers. 275 responded to our survey and we engaged with a further 150 face-to-face in carers groups and focus groups. This may explain the low response.

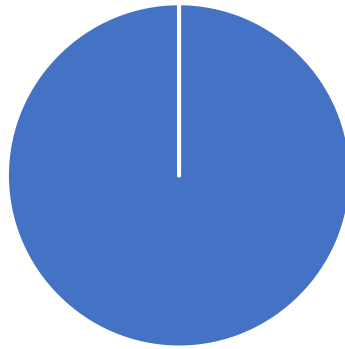
We asked the residents of Bracknell Forest about our five priorities outlined in the strategy and whether they agreed these were correct or had anything else they wanted to add:

The response summary is as follows:

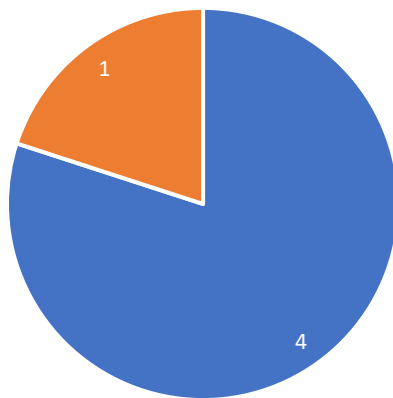


### Services and support that work for carers



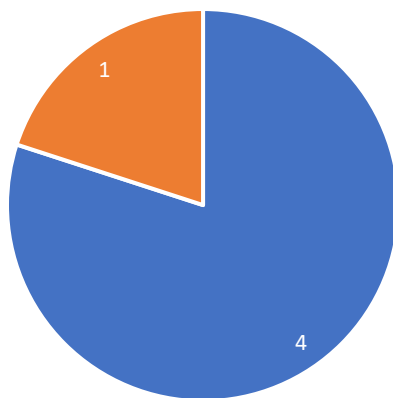
■ Agreed ■ Neither agreed or disagreed
