	To respond to Chief Fire Officer's request that RBFRS deliver a presentation to the Planning Committee on the value of early, properly informed debate on including fire suppression/sprinklers into the design of new buildings	The RBFRS delivered a presentation on this topic to the Planning Committee on 16 October. The Assistant Chief Executive wrote to Cllr Mrs Birch on 30 September to confirm that sprinklers had been incorporated into the new buildings in the Town Centre development.

Quarterly Service Report – Chief Executive's Office	Cllr McLean asked that the Council's response to the consultation concerning additional plane flights over the north of the Borough took account of the views of local residents and Ward Members	Debated at Council on 17 September, when it was resolved ' <i>...the Council asks Heathrow Airport and the National Air Traffic Control Service to confirm they are taking fully into account the views of our residents in this trial and will in future ensure this council is informed of all such changes to flight paths, timings etc. that have the potential to cause concern to our residents.</i> '
