All online card payments are protected by a Secure Socket Layer (SSL) with an encryption key length of 128 bits, which is the highest level commercially available.  Capita Software Services' online payment management solutions are independently and rigorously security assessed, and are certified by Visa and MasterCard as a Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS) Level 1 payment processor.
